CAR PARK AND LANDSCAPING



Ross Solution Projects (RSP) planned and installed a car park with attractive landscaping at a brand new residential development at Ruislip in the West London Borough of Hillingdon. This was an interesting and challenging assignment, involving a tight schedule and adherence to strict local planning regulations.



The project was undertaken during November and December 2020 on behalf of Hillingdon Council and was required to be completed in six weeks. The parking facility serves two buildings which house 31 high quality apartments and this new build development stands adjacent to the recently renovated South Ruislip Library in Victoria Road, HA4.

An average of eight RSP personnel were present on the site daily, although this number could rise to up to 15 when the work required it. Operations involved laying an asphalt surfaced parking area of 1,000 square metres, within which our line marking team then used their skills to create 20 parking bays and two disabled parking spaces with room for vehicles to manoeuvre safely.



Adjacent to car park, we planned and planted a landscaped area of grass, trees and shrubs to enhance the outdoor environment of the apartment buildings. This involved laying some 500 square metres of turf and creating a planted area of about 250 square metres.

The entire project brought in an RSP team of men skilled in three individual trades, supported by a wide range of equipment including excavators, dumpers and rollers.



We are delighted to report that the South Ruislip project was completed on time to meet the 6-week allocated schedule and that our client was very satisfied with the result.
